
- The First Party party will actively engage in the delivery of the Internship/training program and aid in the placement of eligible students of the Second Party.



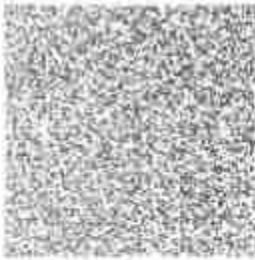

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RENT AGREEMENT

This Rent Agreement is made and executed on this 05th Day of Feb 2019 between **Udaya School of Engineering** through **Mr. Jothi Basu S** hereinafter called the '**LESSOR**' of the one part and **Edujoin Training Foundation** through **Ms. Mohanamurugan S** (SPOC) hereinafter called the '**LESSEE**' of the other part.

Whereas the **LESSOR** is the Owner of the Udaya School of Engineering, Udaya Nagar, Vellamodi Ammandivilaipo, Kanyakumari District, Tamil Nadu-629204 hereinafter referred to as the Demised Premises has agreed to let out the premises (Approx. 9000 Sq. Ft.) of the Demised Premises in favor of the LESSEE against a monthly rent of Rs 35000 (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only) and the LESSEE has also agreed on rent:

NOW THIS RENT AGREEMENT WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That LESSOR undertakes and declares that they have good right and title and interest in the Demised Premises and have full Power to give the said premises (Approx. 9000 sq. Ft.) of Demised Premises on Lease to the LESSEE.
2. That the rent commences from 05th February 2019 for 24 months tenure which may be extended up-to 36 months with mutual consent of both the parties.
3. It is hereby agreed between the parties that both the Parties will have the right to terminate this Lease Agreement at any time by giving a Two (2) months advance notice in writing.
4. That the LESSEE has agreed to an increment in rent by 5% on last paid rent after every Eleven months.
5. That the rent agreement has been made for 24 months tenure with extension up-to 36 months with mutual consent of both the parties, however LESSOR will extend this Lease for another 1 years and then again for 1 years with 5% increment every year of the last paid rent.
6. That the LESSEE shall not make any concrete alteration etc. in the said premises but can make any partition, interior, etc. at its own cost & effects, any leakage, seepage / water logging due to any reason comes inside the said premises and damages the fixtures, electrical items and furniture, the entire liability will be of LESSOR to get it repaired / changed according to our designs.
7. The LESSOR will arrange for lighting in common areas i.e. drive way, stairs and on the main gates in the Demised Premises.
8. That the LESSEE will arrange for a generator for power backup for the Ground floor premises, at his own cost. The LESSOR will only provide the LESSEE suitable space for Generator within the building premises to place.
9. The LESSOR will provide a secure entry to the Ground floor premises, of the Demised Premises.

- 10 LESSOR will provide minimum 200 sq ft of space in front of the building for sign board and space for Parking.
- 11 The LESSEE shall not use the Premises for any illegal or immoral purpose or use it so as to cause any nuisance or annoyance to the other owner/ occupant of the said building.
- 12 That the LESSEE has no right to assign sublet or grant license to use or part the possession of the Premises or any part thereof.
- 13 The LESSOR has the right to enter the property for routine inspection only after informing to the LESSEE.
- 14 That it shall be the responsibility of the LESSEE to undertake minor repair maintenance at their own expenses. LESSOR shall effect all major repairs such as leakage / seepage / water logging / water pipes or cracks etc, inside the said premises, at his cost immediately upon such defects being notified to him by the LESSEE.
